ORDER

San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company is authorized to construct one spur track at grade across 21st Street in the City. of San Diego, San Diego County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 36D-2.2. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation, and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding six per cent. Protection shall be by two existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-E).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant states that the industry to be served has declared its urgent need for the trackage, and requests that the order be made effective upon its date. For this reason the offective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
