O R D E R

City of San Leandro is authorized to construct West Avenue 135 at grade across a drill track of the Southern Pacific Company in San Leandro, Alameda County, at the two locations described in the application, the easterly location to be identified as Crossing No. D-15.80-C and the westerly location to be identified as Crossing No. D-16.15-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than three per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection of each crossing shall be by two Standard No. 1-A crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B) or by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheeting.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Inasmuch as the applicant has indicated a condition of urgency resulting from inability of work forces to complete an

extensive paving project because of lack of authority for construction of said crossings, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
