SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Application No. 27412, a new certificate of public convenience and necessity was granted to A. W. Way in the place and stead of all highway common carrier operative rights then held by him which were revoked and annulled. In the above-entitled Second Supplemental Application No. 27412 applicant points out that in so doing a prescriptive highway common carrier operative right long held by said applicant authorizing service between Eureka and Ferndale and intermediate points was inadvertently omitted from the new certificate. The Commission is requested to amend said Decision No. 39081 to include that operative right.

After full consideration of applicant's request and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 39081 dated June 11, 1946 is hereby amended by including in Paragraph (1) of the order thereof

the following language:

"f. Between Eureka and Ferndale and all intermediate points general commodities except those of unusual value and except high explosives, livestock, household goods (when transported as a separate and distinct service in connection with so-called household moving), commodities in bulk, commodities requiring special equipment and those injurious or contaminating to other lading."

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
