## ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct extensions to a side track and a spur track at grade across Kern Street in the City of Newman, Stanislaus County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. EA-119.2. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding four percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheeting. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintonance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not axercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization

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may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
