ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Counsel for applicant in the above entitled proceedings has requested that the matters be dismissed.

Section 816.5 of Article 5 of the Public Utilities Code, as amended in 1953, now reads as follows:

816.5. Nothing contained in this article shall be construed to require a highway common carrier, a petroleum irregular route carrier or passenger stage corporation to secure from the Commission authority to execute any conditional sales contract for the purchase of motor vehicle equipment or any note and chattel mortgage on motor vehicle equipment securing the payment of all or any part of the purchase price of such motor vehicle equipment. (Added 1951, Ch. 1493; amended 1953, Ch. 1039.)

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Application No. 34861 and Application No. 34862 of Pacific Greyhound Lines be, and they hereby are, dismissed without prejudice.

This order of dismissal will become effective upon the date hereof.
