ORDER

The verified application of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, filed on October 22, 1953, discloses that the amount of passenger and freight business transacted at applicant's station of Lacto during the past several years no longer warrants its continued maintenance.

Good cause appearing, The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Lacto, County of San Joaquin; to remove a sixteen car side track, station platform, mail crane, scale house and station sign at said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised

within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
