O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an industrial drill track at grade across Doolittle Drive near San Leandro, Alameda County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. L-15.88-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The applicant has stated that one of the industries to be served by the proposed track requests that the track be installed as

soon as possible in order to receive building materials for construction purposes in the immediate future.

Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
