FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 46549, dated December 18, 1951, Desert Water Company⁽¹⁾ was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate a public utility water system in its Victorville Water System No. 3, subject to the condition that no such certificate of public convenience and necessity should be considered to have been granted to applicant until a report of the final development of an adequate water supply in Section 16, Township 4 North, Range 2 West, on land deeded to applicant, shall have been filed with the Commission.

By its letters to the Commission dated November 5, 1953, and December 8, 1953, applicant has furnished proof to the Commission of its ownership of a well lot in Tract No. 3820

By Decision No. 48648, dated June 1, 1953, in Application No. 34371, Desert Water Company and Mountain Properties, Inc., were consolidated into a new corporation known as Pacific Water Co.

and of its development of a source of water supply through a well, the pumping plant installation in which has a tested production capacity of 295 gallons per minute.

By the proof contained in its letters, it appears that applicant has satisfied the condition in Decision No. 46549 and that a certificate of public convenience and necessity should now be granted to applicant with respect to its Victorville Water System No. 3; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be, and it is, granted to Desert Water Company, now Pacific Water Co., to operate a public utility water system in its Victorville Water System No. 3.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that:

1. Applicant be, and it is, authorized to refile its presently filed preliminary statement, Schedule No. 2, General Metered Service, to include the territory within Section 16, Township 4 North, Range 2 West, known as its Victorville Water System No. 3, in accordance with the requirements of General Order No. 96, to be effective on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

2. Applicant shall file, within forty days after the effective date of this order, four copies of a comprehensive map drawn to an indicated scale of not less than 2,000 feet to the inch, delineating by appropriate markings the various

tracts of land and territory served and the location of the properties served by applicant.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
