ORDER

The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct an additional spur track at grade across an unnamed alloy between 19th. 20th. "D" and "E" Stroots in the City of Sacramente. Sacramente County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 4-139.05-D. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superclovation and of a width to conform to the portion of the alloy now graded, with tops of rails flush with the readway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Frotection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.
