Pacific Electric Railway Company having requested relief as provided in Section 576 (d) of the Vehicle Code at certain crossings at grade, and good cause appearing

IT IS ORDERED that approval is hereby granted for the display of distinctive "exempt" signs (Vehicle Code Section 576 (d); General Order No. 98) at the following spur track crossings:

6K-7.39-C	6649 Santa Monica Boulevard

6K-7.66-C	1121 North Highland Avenue

6EA-7.72-C	6901 " " "
6EA-7.78-C	7009 " " "
6EA-7.95-C	Between La Brea Avenue and Formosa Avenue on Santa Monica Boulevard
6EA-8.25-C	Fuller Street and Santa Monica Boulevard
6H-11.01-C	Approximately 160 feet east of San Vicente Boulevard on Melrose Avenue

Such signs shall comply with General Order No. 98 and shall be erected and maintained by the proper authorities. Within thirty days after erection of such signs, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This approval does not exempt any vehicle from observance of any provision of the Vehicle Code and shall become void if signs are not displayed within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Approval may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Application No. 34476 be dismissed without prejudice.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
