In the Matter of the Application of ERNEST E. STUBBLEFIELD, for renewal of license as a Motor Transportation Broker for the year 1954.

<u>opinion</u>

In the above-entitled application Ernest E. Stubblefield states that he desires to continue business as a motor transportation broker for which he had obtained a license from the Commission by Decision No. 48203 dated January 27, 1953, in Application No. 33991. License certificate No. 1 issued pursuant to that decision expired December 31, 1953, and is renewable subject to the provisions of the statute and those prescribed by the Commission.

Applicant states that his brokerage business would be continued at Room 228, Wholesale Terminal Building, 1304 East Seventh Street, Los Angeles, California. He plans to continue as a broker for the same truck carriers for which he held a license during 1953.

Applicant has on file with the Commission a bond required by the provisions of Section 4838 of the Public Utilities Code. After full consideration of applicant's request it appears that the license should be renewed for the remainder of the year 1954. A public hearing is not deemed necessary.

ORDER

An application therefor having been filed and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a license is hereby granted to Ernest E. Stubblefield for the remainder of the year 1954 to act as a motor

transportation broker, as defined in Section 4803 of the Public Utilities Code, subject to the following conditions:

- (a) That said licensee shall keep his license cortificate as a motor transportation broker posted at his authorized place of business so that it is readily available to public inspection at all times.
- (b) That said licensee shall do business as a motor transportation broker at 228 Wholesale Terminal Building, 1304 East Seventh Street, Los Angeles 21, California, until otherwise authorized by the Commission, and for motor carriers hereinafter named, or for whom he may hereafter from time to time be permitted to do business by any subsequent order or orders of the Commission.
- (2) That the license of said applicant shall authorize him to sell, offer for sale, negotiate for, furnish or provide transportation of property over the public highways of this state, to be furnished only by the carriers whose names, addresses and permit numbers follows, to-wit:
