FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 49133 of September 29, 1953, in this proceeding, authorized applicant to increase its fares. The fare between Palm Springs and Palm Springs Station was not included in this adjustment. Authority is now sought to increase the one-way fare between these points from \$1.00 to \$1.30 and the round-trip fare from \$2.00 to \$2.60.

Applicant alleges that the proposed increase was inadvertently omitted from the original application. It further alleges that this operation has experienced increased costs similar to those experienced in the rest of its operations. The amount of additional revenue involved is about \$550 per year. While it will not materially affect the over-all operating results, the proposed increase is necessary in order to distribute the burden of added cost equitably.

In the circumstance it appears that the proposed increase in fares is justified and should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Tanner Motor Tours, Ltd., be and it is hereby authorized to establish increased one-way and round-trip fares of \$1.30 and \$2.60, respectively, between Palm Springs and Palm Springs Station.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within sixty days after the effective date of this order.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
