ORDER

City of San Leandro is authorized to construct Alvarado Street at grade across a drill track of Southern Pacific Company in San Leandro, Alameda County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. D-15.92-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 46 feet and grades of approach not greater than four percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 (G. O. No.72). Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No.75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflecting material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
