ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Petition for Modification No. 4, filed in this proceeding by Elmer Ahl as agent for certain common carriers of petroleum products in motor vehicles, seeks revision of the boundaries of various "territorial groups" as described in City Carriers' Tariff No. 5, Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 6. The petition was filed on June 24, 1953. Petitioner is not yet ready to proceed to hearing. The Commission is informed that changes in the proposal are contemplated. Under these circumstances the petition will be dismissed, without prejudice, for want of prosecution.

Therefore, good cause appearing;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the aforesaid petition be and it is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
