SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Under General Order No. 84C carriers handling C.O.D. shipments are required to provide a bond of not less than \$2,000 and file the bond with the Commission. The bonding provisions were established primarily for the protection of shippers. Certain pharmacies located in Sacramento waived this protection in connection with C.O.D. service provided by Mabel Alice Benenato. By Decision No. 48435 of March 30, 1953, as amended, she was authorized to handle C.O.D. shipments for these pharmacies without filing a bond. Fort Sutter Pharmacy of Sacramento has now informed the Commission in writing that the bonding of the carrier is not necessary in connection with its C.O.D. consignments.

In the circumstances the authority granted by Decision No. 48435, as amended, should be further amended to include Fort Sutter Pharmacy. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 48435 of March 30, 1953, as amended, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby further amended by including Fort Sutter Pharmacy as one of the shippers covered by the authority involved.

In all other respects said Decision No. 48435 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
