<u>OPINION</u>

Pacific Gas and Electric Company in this proceeding asks for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to exercise the rights and privileges of a franchise granted by the City of Mill Valley, permitting the installation, maintenance and use of an electric distribution and transmission system upon the streets of said city. A public hearing was held before Examiner Silverhart on January 29, 1954 at San Francisco.

The franchise referred to, a copy of which is attached to the application and designated as Exhibit A, was granted by the city in accordance with the Franchise Act of 1937, and is of indeterminate duration. A fee is payable annually to the city equivalent to two per cent of the gross receipts arising from the use, operation, or possession of the franchise, but not less than one-half per cent of the gross annual receipts from sales of electricity within the limits of the city under said franchise.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be and is granted to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to exercise the rights and privileges granted by the City of Mill Valley by Ordinance No. 413 adopted September 16, 1953.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.)
