## ORINION

This is on application for an order authorizing fina Mideleton Akins to transfer certain highway comon cerricer operative mights and properties to Earry Wendell.

Applicant Akins, doing business as A. M. Aksns, is engeged in the operation of a highway common carrier service for the transportation of property in Lake County. Ee repurts that he has attained the age of 81 years and desires to retire from the business of operating his highwey common carrier service for the reason thet he foels it is detfimental to his health. Accordingly, he has made arrangements to selil his operative rights and properties to Earry Wendell for the sum of $\$ 7,000$. The propertice inciude operative rights acquired by appiicant akins under authorization granted by the Commission by Decision No. 23910, dated July 24, 2931, anc Decision No. 34453, dated Juily 29, 1941, and two Chevrolet $1 \frac{1}{2}-t o n$ trucks.

The application shows that Harry Wencell is engeged in the garage business at Clear Lake Eighlands and that finencialiy he
is in a position to take over and continue the hifhway common carricr operations. It therefore appears that the proposed transfer will not be adverse to the public interest and should be authorized.

In making our orcer herein we wish to place appliconts upon notice that operative rigints, as such, do not constitute a ciass of property which may be capitaizzed or used as an element of value in rate fixing for any amount of money in excess of that omginaliy paic to the state as the consideration for the grant of such righte. Aside from their purely permissive aspect, they extend to the holed a. full or partiol monopoly of a class of business over a particular routc. This monopoly feature may be changed or destroyed at any time by the state, which is not in any respect iimited as to the number of rights which may be given.

The action taken herein shall not be construed to be a finding of the value of the rights and properties herein authorized to be transferrec.

The Commision having considered the above entithed matter, and being of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted, as hercin provided; therefore,

IT IS EEREBY ORDERED as follows:
2. Aima Micdieton Akins, deing business as A. M. Akins, may soll and transfer to Harry Wendell the operative rights and properties reforred to in the preceding opinion.
2. Within 60 days after tine effective carte hereof and on not less than five cays' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicants shall supplement or reissue the tariffs on 1110 with the Commission roaming rates, rules and regulations goveminig the common carrier operations here involved to show that Alma Miedicton Akins has withdrawn or canceled and Harry Wendell has adopted or established as his own said rates; rules and regulations. The tariff filings mace pursuant to this order shall comply in all respects with the regulations goveming the filing and construction of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 80.
3. The authority herein granted will become effective upon the date hereof.
