## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 49325, on Application No. 33690, applicant, Joseph L. Bonita was authorized to establish and operato as a highway common carrier for the transportation of various named commodities between a certain described area in Los Angeles and named cities and towns, including Covina. Covina was named through inadvertance in place and stead of Corona, and should not have been named as applicant is specifically prohibited from transporting any shipment to or from points intermediate of the Los Angeles area and Pomona and Upland. Covina is a point intermediate of Los Angeles and Pomona.

Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that paragraph (1) of the order in said Decision No. 49325 be, and it hereby is, amended by deleting the city of "Covina" therefrom, and in place and stead thereof adding the city of "Corona".

Except as herein authorized, Decision No. 49325 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
