O P I N I O N

Stockton City Lines, Inc. seeks authority to reroute a minor portion of its Sheltered Oaks Route No. 4-A.

Applicant proposes to discontinue operating over Miner Avenue between Grant and Ophir Streets and over Ophir Street between Oak Street and Miner Avenue and, in lieu thereof, to operate along Grant Street between Oak Street and Miner Avenue and along Oak Street between Grant and Ophir Streets.

Applicant alleges that by such rerouting, service will be provided for the patrons of a number of stores and industries not presently served, that such rerouting will eliminate one bus stop at Miner Avenue and Ophir Street and one at Fremont and Ophir Streets; that passengers presently utilizing such stops will not be seriously inconvenienced because of the availability of a stop at Oak and Ophir Streets, one block north of Fremont and Ophir Streets; that Routes Nos. 2 and 3 which traverse Weber Avenue, only two blocks south of Ophir Street and Miner Avenue, provide its patrons a choice of two lines; that frequency of service will remain as at present, as will fares.

Under the circumstances here disclosed, the Commission is of the opinion that the application should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

ORDER

An application having been filed and the Commission being of the opinion that the authority requested should be granted,

IT IS ORDERED that Route No. 4-A--Sheltered Oaks, set forth in ordering paragraph (6) of Decision No. 45344 dated February 6, 1951, Applications Nos. 30577 and 31894, is amended as follows:

ROUTE NO. 4-A--SHELTERED OAKS

Starting at the intersection of Weber Avenue and Grant Street, thence along Grant Street, Oak Street, North Ophir Street, Harding Way, Sycamore Avenue, Walnut Street, Funston Avenue, Sanguinetti Lane, Robindale Avenue, Belle Street, Vail Street, U. S. Highway 99, Sanguinetti Lane to Robindale Avenue.

Also, along Harding Way between El Dorado Street and North Ophir Street.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
