ORDER VACATING DECISION

Ex parte Decision No. 49597 authorized City of Covina to construct Barranca Street at grade across the San Bernardino Line of Pacific Electric Railway Company (Crossing No. 6T-22.23), and provided that applicant "shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails." Applicant has filed a petition requesting that the decision be vacated for the purpose of having a hearing on the application, and desires to introduce evidence for the purpose of showing that the City of Covina should not bear the entire construction cost of the grade crossing.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 49597 is hereby vacated and set aside, and that Application No. 34881 be set for public hearing.

The Secretary is directed to cause copies of this order to be served upon the parties, and to cause appropriate notice of hearing to be mailed at least ten (10) days prior to such hearing.
