## OPINION

Palm Springs Water Company has filed this application for authorization to sell to Mt. San Jacinto Winter Park Authority, for the sum of \$5,000, a parcel of land located in the County of Riverside and described as follows:

Section 3, T4S, R3E, S.B.B. & M.

Subject to reservations, rights, rights of way easement of record, and current taxes not delinquent.

According to the verified application, said Section 3 consists of unimproved mountainous land located on the east slope of Mt. San Jacinto. It is traversed by Falls Creck a short distance above its juncture with Snow Creek and above the headworks and diversion facilities of the utility system. Upon acquiring the property, Mt. San Jacinto Winter Park Authority proposes to transfer it to the United States Forest Service, whereupon it will become a part of the National Forest.

From a review of this application it appears that the transfer will not be adverse to the public interest. With the ultimate acquisition by the United States Forest Service, it is anticipated that the water in Falls Creek will continue to flow

Company at the same price at which it herein is authorized to be sold.

- (B) The grantee or any subsequent transferee shall not put the property referred to in this proceeding to any use which may be prejudicial to the continued use by the grantor in the discharge of its public duty as a public utility.
- 3. The authority herein granted will become effective upon the date hereof and will expire unless exercised on or before March 31, 1954.
