SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Canned goods and other foodstuffs are listed in Item No. 610 series of Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 2. The listing should be revised so that the application of the rates will clearly be restricted to food syrups.

Commodity rates for the transportation of infusorial earth from White Hills to San Francisco Territory are intermediate in application subject to the routings in Item No. 900. That item should be amended to provide a specific routing from White Hills.

A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 2 (Appendix "D" of Decision No. 31606' as amended) be and it is hereby further amended by incorporating therein to become effective April 1, 1954, the revised pages attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, which pages are numbered as follows:
