Good cause appearing, Southern Pacific Company 1s authorized to abandon its Class "A" non-agency station of Arena, County of Merced; to remove a spur track of approximately 1141 feet in length and station facilities at said station; to climinate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than rive days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
