O R D E R

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct "Bard Road Underpass" (State Route XI-Imp-FAS 721) at separated grades under the tracks of Southern Pacific Company near Winterhaven; Imperial County, at the location as shown by the map attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B-731.6-B. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with the terms of an agreement to be entered into between the applicant, the railroad, and the County of Imperial, and a copy of said agreement, together with plans approved by the railroad, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencement of construction. In the event the parties are unable to negotiate the assumption of cost, the Commission will apportion such cost by future order.

Upon completion, Crossing No. B-731.7-B, approximately 500 feet east, shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
