ORDER VACATING

ORDER GRANTING TELIPORARY INTERIM RELIEF

Decision No. 49679 directed defendant to restore telephone service to complainant pending hearing on the complaint and further Commission order thereon. Answer to the complaint was filed on February 26, 1954. On March 5, 1954 defendant filed the affidavit of A. E. Fickle, an employee of defendant.

Affiant states that on February 24, 1954 he personally called upon complainant at the latter's residence, that complainant stated that he planned to go East within the next two weeks and did not know if he would retain his present address or move elsewhere; that complainant stated that he did not know when he will want his telephone service reconnected; that complainant stated that he will call defendant when he returns from the East and will advise defendant of the address where complainant then wants telephone service to be reconnected.
