ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to construct one spur track at grade across Obispo Avenue and an alley located between Obispo and Coronado Avenues, in the City of Long Beach, Los Angeles County, at the locations described in the application. The spur track across Obispo Avenue shall be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 6E-20.02 and across the alley as Crossing No. 6E-20.05-CD. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superlevation, and of a width to conform to the portion of the roadways now graded, with tops of rails flush with pavement and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection of Crossing No. 6E-20.02 shall be by two Standard No. 3 wigwags and protection of Crossing No. 6E-20.05-CD shall be by one Standard No. 2 suspended crossing sign (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
