OPINION AND ORDER

Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, by the above-entitled application filed March 2, 1954, asks the Commission for authority to carry out the terms and conditions of an agreement, dated February 18, 1954, with H. E. West, doing business as the Placerville Lumber Company, relating to the temporary delivery and sale as an accommodation by Pacific Gas and Electric Company of surplus water from its El Dorado Canal for use in connection with the operation of a lumber mill located at Fresh Pond, El Dorado County. This agreement will expire on December 31, 1954.

A prior agreement, substantially the same as the agreement presented herein except for executed and expiration dates, was approved by the Commission in its Decision No. 48200, dated January 27, 1953.

The Commission having considered the request of the applicant and being of the opinion that the application should be granted and that a public hearing is not necessary; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, be and it is authorized to carry out the terms and conditions of the agreement with H. E. West, doing business as the

Placerville Lumber Company; dated February 18, 1954, as set forth in Exhibit A attached to the application, which exhibit is made a part of this order by reference.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that:

1. Applicant shall file with this Commission within thirty days after the effective date of this order two certified copies of the agreement as executed, together with a statement of the date on which the agreement is deemed to have become effective.
2. Applicant shall notify this Commission of the date of termination of said agreement within thirty days from and after said date of termination.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
