Application of the County of Sacramento)
 to construct a grade crossing of The) Application No. 35138
 Western Pacific Railroad at Florin Road.)

O R D E R

The County of Sacramento is authorized to widen and reconstruct the crossing at grade of Florin Road with a track of The Western Pacific Railroad Company, (Crossing No. 4-132.9) near Sacramento, Sacramento County, as described in the application and in substantial accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be not less than 36 feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals.(G. O. No. 75-B).

Construction expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. The Western Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
