In the Matter of the Application of Haslett Warehouse Company, a corporation, for authorization to suspend operation of certain public utility warehouse facilities at San Francisco, California.

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 48405 of March 24, 1953, Haslett Warehouse Company was authorized to suspend for one year the operation of 126,680 square feet of warehouse space in San Francisco. A oneyear extension of this authority is sought.

Applicant alleges that it has made a diligent effort to obtain suitable replacement space but will be unable to secure it prior to April 13, 1954, the expiration date of the present suspension authority.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the sought extension is justified.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted Haslett Warehouse Company by Decision No. 48405 of March 24, 1953, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby extended to April 13, 1955, unless sooner canceled, changed or extended by order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
