OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant operates as a public utility warehouseman. By this application, as amended, he seeks authority to discontinue service at one of his San Francisco warehouse locations. The floor space involved is 23,000 square feet. The warehouse was operated under a lease which has been canceled because the building has been condemned. Applicant states that he has adequate facilities without the space in question.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the granting of the sought authority is justified.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Warren Ballinger, doing business as Warren Ballinger Drayage Co., be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue the operation of 23,000 square feet of warehouse floor space in San Francisco.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
