SECOND INTERIM ORDER  
RELIEVING CERTAIN RESPONDENTS  
FROM FILING QUARTERLY REPORTS

On March 24, 1953 the California Public Utilities Commission issued its interim opinion and order (Decision No. 48384) in the above-entitled proceeding directing each respondent to file quarterly reports showing separately the number of unfilled applications for main service and the number of unfilled requests for regrades of service.

Reports for the four quarters of 1953 show that 15 small companies reported no unfilled applications for main service and no unfilled requests for regrades of service during the year. Three other companies showed no held orders or requests for regrades at the end of 1953. Analysis shows that seven of these small companies offered only farmer line or toll station service. Of the remaining 11 companies, none served more than 800 stations as of December 31, 1952.

Inasmuch as it appears that these 18 telephone companies are providing service on a current basis and in the interest of relieving them from filing further reports pursuant to Decision No. 48384, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the respondents listed in the attachment to this order are relieved from the requirement to file quarterly reports of unfilled applications for main service and unfilled requests for regrades of service as directed by the interim order in Decision No. 48384.

The Secretary is directed to serve a certified copy of this order upon each respondent named on the attachment hereto.

In all other respects Decision No. 48384 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
