O R D E R

City and County of San Francisco is authorized to construct Army Street at grade across tracks of The Western Pacific Railroad Company, Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company and Southern Pacific Company in the City and County of San Francisco, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 2SF-1.80. Construction and maintenance costs shall be borne in accordance with an agreement between the interested parties. If such agreement is not attainable, then said costs shall be borne in accordance with the terms of a supplemental order issued by this Commission. Width of crossing shall be not less than the width of Army Street as shown on Exhibit "A" in the application and grades of approach shall be not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 (General Order No. 72). Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflecting material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or

safety so require.

The applicant states that it is urgent that Army Street be paved at an early date. Consequently, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
