ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Under date of December 17, 1953, the South Bay Irrigation District filed a complaint against California Water & Telephone Company relative to the question as to whether or not certain properties lie within the dedicated service area of the Sweetwater District of the defendant company. On January 26, 1954 an answer was filed by defendant generally denying the complaint and requesting its dismissal.

A public hearing was held before Examiner Syphers in San Diego on March 4, 1954, at which time the complainant requested dismissal of its complaint and referred to a letter dated February 24, 1954, setting out the terms of an understanding which has been reached between the parties hereto. This letter is in the Commission files.

In view of these circumstances the complaint will be dismissed without prejudice to the rights of the complainant or any other parties to inquire into the service area at any appropriate future time. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the above-entitled matter be and it hereby is dismissed without prejudice.
