## OPINION

In the above-entitled application, as amended, Frank D. Davi seeks a license to engage in business as a motor transportation broker as defined in Section 4803 of the Public Utilities Code.

According to the application, applicant resides at 1000 Cabrillo Street, San Francisco. He proposes to conduct business as a motor transportation broker at 143 Drumm Street, San Francisco. Attached to the application are letters from eight motor carriers authorizing applicant to sell transportation over their lines, viz.:

All cargo insurance, C.O.D. bonds, collection of freight charges, preparation of shipping documents and freight bills will be obligations of the carriers. The applicant will make arrangements for the shipment of commodities and will furnish the carrier with a pickup order showing the name and address of the shippor, the typo of haul and its destination. All other arrangements for the transportation of cargo will be made between the carrier and the shipper.

The applicant states that he will not be responsible for loss or damage of any kind to shipments. The collection of the transportation charges will be the obligation of the carriers.

Applicant assorts that he has not proviously sold, offered for sale or hold himself out to furnish or provide transportation by motor carriers. A bond has boon filed as required by law.

After full consideration of all the evidence in this proceeding, we find no reason to withhold issuance of the license sought by applicant, which will be granted.

## ORDER

An application as above-ontitled having been filed and based upon the conclusions expressed in the foregoing opinion, IT IS ORDERED:

transportation broker in the form heretofore approved by the Commission for such license certificate and subject to the conditions hereinabove specified.
