O P I N I O N

In the above-entitled application, as amended, Frank D. Davi seeks a license to engage in business as a motor transportation broker as defined in Section 4803 of the Public Utilities Code.

According to the application, applicant resides at 1000 Cabrillo Street, San Francisco. He proposes to conduct business as a motor transportation broker at 143 Drumm Street, San Francisco. Attached to the application are letters from eight motor carriers authorizing applicant to sell transportation over their lines, viz.:

In conducting his proposed business, applicant states that all his arrangements with carriers and with shippers will be oral. ✓  
He proposes to charge the carriers the following fees, viz:

- Part load: (a) \$5 for part loads on which the freight charge is less than \$75.  
(b) \$7 for part loads on which freight charges exceed \$75.
- Full load: \$10 on full loads regardless of weight or freight charges.

All cargo insurance, C.O.D. bonds, collection of freight charges, preparation of shipping documents and freight bills will be obligations of the carriers. The applicant will make arrangements for the shipment of commodities and will furnish the carrier with a pickup order showing the name and address of the shipper, the type of haul and its destination. All other arrangements for the transportation of cargo will be made between the carrier and the shipper.

The applicant states that he will not be responsible for loss or damage of any kind to shipments. The collection of the transportation charges will be the obligation of the carriers.

Applicant asserts that he has not previously sold, offered for sale or held himself out to furnish or provide transportation by motor carriers. A bond has been filed as required by law.

After full consideration of all the evidence in this proceeding, we find no reason to withhold issuance of the license sought by applicant, which will be granted.

#### ORDER

An application as above-entitled having been filed and based upon the conclusions expressed in the foregoing opinion;

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a license is hereby granted to Frank D. Davi to act as a motor transportation broker, as defined in Section 4803, subject to the following conditions:

- (a) That licensee shall keep his license certificate as a motor transportation broker available at all times to public inspection.
- (b) That licensee shall do business as a motor transportation broker only at 143 Drumm Street, San Francisco, and for motor carriers hereinafter named or for whom he may hereafter from time to time be permitted to do business by any subsequent order or orders of the Commission.

(2) That the license of said applicant shall authorize him to sell, offer for sale, negotiate for, furnish or provide transportation of property over the public highways of this state to be furnished only by the carriers whose names and addresses are as follows:

(3) That the Secretary of the Commission issue and deliver to said applicant a license certificate as such motor

transportation broker in the form heretofore approved by the Commission for such license certificate and subject to the conditions hereinabove specified.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
