ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

It appearing by Decision No. 42330, dated December 21, 1948, in Application No. 29888, that Floyd Cross and Harriet Cross were authorized to sell and transfer to Wilson Kirk the operative right created by Decision No. 15415, dated September 19, 1925, in Application No. 11232, authorizing the operation of a highway common carrier service for the transportation of milk and other dairy products from certain points in the Antelope Valley south of Rosamond and from Saugus and Newhall, to Burbank and Los Angeles, and for the return transportation of articles used in the business of dairying, and also for the general transportation of freight of all classes, upon demand, between Bouquet Canyon and Los Angeles; it further appearing by letter to this Commission, dated December 10, 1953, from said Wilson Kirk, that Wilson Kirk is not presently operating the above-described service and has not operated same for a substantial period of time; and it further appearing that this discontinuance of said service is without Commission authorization; therefore,

IT IS FOUND AS A FACT that Wilson Kirk is no longer operating and has unlawfully abandoned said highway common carrier service.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity transferred to Wilson Kirk by Decision No. 42330 in the above-entitled proceeding is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs on file in the name of Wilson Kirk, also known as W. W. Kirk and Woodrow W. Kirk, are hereby canceled.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Wilson Kirk in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after lawful service thereof upon Wilson Kirk, unless said Wilson Kirk before such effective date shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will thereby be stayed until hearing is held and further order issued.
