OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant, Daryl R. Druhe, requests authority to discontinue that portion of his passenger stage operation between Boulder Creek and Big Basin, and intermediate points.

Said service was authorized on a seasonal basis during the summer months by Decision No. 40468, dated June 28, 1947, in Application No. 28481.

As justification for the authority sought applicant alleges that during the period from June 16, 1953 through September 8, 1953, he traveled 3,024 bus miles between Boulder Creek and Big Basin transporting 284 passengers at a total revenue of \$140.58.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity no longer require said service; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Daryl R. Druhe is hereby authorized to discontinue service between Boulder Creek and Big Basin and intermediate points, and the authority granted by Decision No. 40468 is hereby revoked and annulled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Daryl R. Druhe, on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, shall amend his tariff and timetable on file with the Commission to show that the operation here involved has been discontinued.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
