O R D E R

The verified application of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company filed on March 11, 1954 discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Dinsmore during the past two years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good cause appearing, Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to abandon its Class "B" non-agency station of Dinsmore, County of Humboldt; to remove a spur track of approximately 1979.1 feet in length at said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
