SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

City Carriers' Tariff No. 6 - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 7 provides minimum rates for the transportation of rock, sand, gravel and related commodities in dump truck equipment. By Decision No. 48859 of July 21, 1953, in this proceeding, zone rates were established for the transportation of these commodities within San Bernardino and Riverside Counties.

By this petition California Dump Truck Owners Association seeks revision of these rates. Petitioner points out that the rates established by Decision No. 48859 were based on a formula originally developed for another shipping area. It asserts that the use of this formula has resulted in excessively low rates for short hauls and slightly high rates for long hauls and that, in many respects, the present rates have been found to be unsuitable.

Petitioner states that it has conducted studies of the rates in question and has developed a formula which produces a more satisfactory rate structure. Both increases and reductions result from the use of the new formula. Petitioner alleges that the new formula takes into account an increase in the carriers' operating costs of approximately 5 percent.

The petition is supported by various associations in San Bernardino and Riverside Counties who have in their membership nearly all of the shippers and carriers utilizing the zone rates herein involved.

In the circumstances, it appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and the proposed revisions of the minimum rates are justified. However, the adoption of the proposed basis of rates for this matter is not to be construed as setting a precedent for future adjustments of these or other rates.

In addition it has been brought to our attention that a zone rate from Orange County Production Area "D" to Orange County Delivery Zone "6-A" (and that San Diego zone numbers on page 37-A were) *omitted* incorrectly stated in the tariff revisions made by Decision No. 48712 of June 16, 1953, in Case No. 4808. The necessary corrections will be made.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that City Carriers' Tariff No. 6 - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 7 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 32566 as amended) be and it is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective May 10, 1954, the revised pages attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, which pages are numbered as follows:
