#### SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Minimum rates, rules and regulations for the transportation of property in the East Bay drayage area are set forth in City Carriers' Tariff No. 2-A - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A (Appendix "A" to Decision No. 41362 as amended). Class rates are governed by Western Classification ratings and by specified exceptions. The exceptions include a fourth class rating on designated canned goods and groceries and grocers' supplies.

The Draymen's Association of Alameda County and the Pacific Motor Tariff Bureau seek the inclusion of pectin in the canned goods exception and of laundry wax compound in the groceries and grocers' supply exception. Under this proposal pectin would be reduced from third to fourth class and laundry wax compound from second to fourth class.

Petitioners state that the commodities involved are usually shipped in small quantities and in mixed shipments with canned goods or other groceries. The transportation characteristics of pectin and the wax compound are represented as comparing favorably with the grocery items accorded fourth class rates. It is alleged that billing would be greatly facilitated if the products in question were rated the same as those now covered by the canned goods and grocery exceptions.

Interested parties have been notified of the filing of the petition. No objection to its being granted has been offered.

In the circumstances, it appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the proposed tariff changes are justified.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that City Carriers' Tariff No. 2-A - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 41362 as amended) be and it is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective May 24, 1954, the following revised pages attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
