SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company has filed a petition for a modification of the protection ordered by Decision No. 47481, alleging that a Standard No. 8 flashing light signal placed on a six-foot cantilever bracket on the north side of Sepulveda Boulevard would furnish greater protection to traffic than would strict compliance with the requirements of said decision.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the protection for Crossing No. 2H-26.5-C required in Item 4 of Decision No. 47481, dated July 15, 1952, be amended to read:

> One Standard No. 8 flashing light signal (General Order No. 75-B) on the south side of the highway and flashing light signals similar to those employed in the Standard No. 8, mounted, however, upon a six-foot cantilever bracket extending toward the highway, for protection on the north side

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of the highway, and night illumination so placed as to illuminate sides of rail cars which might be occupying crossing.

In all other respects Decision No. 47481 shall remain

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
