**O R D E R**

The State of California, Department of Public Works, is authorized to construct a pedestrian crossing at separated grades under the track of The Western Pacific Railroad Company, near Marysville, Yuba County, at the location shown on Exhibits "A", "B" and "C" attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 4-17781BD. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
