ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an additional drill track at grade across Martin Avenue in the City of Santa Clara, Santa Clara County, at the location described in the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

It is alleged that Martin Avenue is not at present open to public use and travel, and this order is not to be deemed authority for such opening. Authorization for the opening of Martin Avenue was granted by Decision No. 49087, which shall remain in full force and effect.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges the industry to be served has an urgent need for the trackage involved, therefore the effective date of this

order shall be the date hereof.
