FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 48513 of April 21, 1953, authorized Robertson Drayage Co., Inc. to suspend the operation of 69,683 square feet of warehouse space in San Francisco until May 11, 1954. An extension of this authority to October 1, 1954 is sought.

Applicant has warehouse facilities to replace the suspended space under construction. However, the new facilities will not be completed until October 1.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the sought extension is justified.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted Robertson Drayage Co., Inc., by Decision No. 48513 of April 21, 1953, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby extended to October 1, 1954.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
