O R D E R

The verified application of Petaluma and Santa Rosa Railroad Company filed on March 26, 1954 discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Alten during the past three years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good cause appearing, Petaluma and Santa Rosa Railroad Company is authorized to abandon its Class "B" non-agency station of Alten, County of Sonoma; to remove a spur track of approximately 309.3 feet in length at said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective

date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
