O P I N I O N

In the above-entitled application Lois V. Hartman seeks a license to engage in business as a motor transportation broker as defined by Section 4803 of the Public Utilities Code.

On April 7, 1953 the Commission issued such a license to this applicant pursuant to her application (Decision No. 48466). That license expired on December 31, 1953 as provided by Section 4842 of the Public Utilities Code. This application, in effect, is a request for a renewal of that license, which should have been filed before the license expired. The record on which said Decision No. 48466 was based showed that the traffic for which applicant was arranging transportation consisted of agricultural products moving in interstate commerce having origin in California and destination in other states. The present application indicates that applicant will continue handling that type of traffic. Her business will be conducted at 405 Lincoln Avenue, Dinuba, California. She has heretofore filed a bond as required by law which is continuous in form.

After full consideration of applicant's request, we find no reason to withhold the issuance of a license which, under said Section 4842, would be effective for the remainder of this calendar year only.

O R D E R

An application therefor having been filed, the Commission being fully informed therein and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a license is hereby granted to Lois V. Hartman to act as a motor transportation broker, as defined in Section 4803 of the Public Utilities Code, subject to the following conditions:

- (a) That licensee shall keep her license certificate as a motor transportation broker available at all times to public inspection.
- (b) That licensee shall do business as a motor transportation broker only at 405 Lincoln Avenue, Dinuba, California, and for the motor carrier hereinafter named, or others for whom she may hereinafter from time to time be permitted to do business by any subsequent order or orders of the Commission.

(2) That the license of said applicant shall authorize her to sell, offer for sale, negotiate for, furnish or provide transportation of property over the public highways of this State to be furnished only by the carrier whose name and address is as follows: Direct Distributing Co., Box 2458, Dallas, Texas.

(3) That the Secretary of the Commission issue and deliver to said applicant a license certificate as such motor transportation broker in the form heretofore adopted by the Commission for such license certificate, and subject to the conditions hereinabove specified.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
