FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 49927, dated April 20, 1954, the Commission authorized Surprise Valley Electrification Corporation to execute a mortgage of realty and chattels and to issue promissory notes in the aggregate principal amount of not exceeding \$1,850,409.26.

Applicant has requested the Commission to provide in its order that the mortgage and the notes may be dated as of March 1, 1954. The Commission has considered this request and is of the opinion it should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the mortgage of realty and chattels and the promissory notes authorized by Decision No. 49927, dated April 20, 1954, may be dated as of March 1, 1954.
