## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 50008 entered today in Case No. 5440 increases the truckload minimum weight on cement in City Carriers' Tariff No. 8 - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 10 from 38,000 to 40,000 pounds. This revision requires a corresponding change in the provisions of City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A affecting the application of less-truckload rates.
