SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 49886 of April 6, 1954, established revised minimum rates, rules and regulations in City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A for San Francisco drayage. The decision provided for an exception rating on cheese which through inadvertence was not included in the tariff revisions. The necessary tariff changes will be made. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 41363 as amended) be and it is hereby further amended by incorporating therein the revised pages attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, which pages are numbered as follows:
