O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a side track at grade across Harrison Avenue and across 50th Avenue in the City of Coachella, County of Riverside, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as portions of Crossings Nos. B-613.9 and B-614.2, respectively. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72 and of a minimum width of 24 feet, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs, with reflex reflecting sheet material, at each crossing (General Order No. 75-B).

Within 30 days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant declares that the side track is urgently needed at this time to facilitate the movement of its trains and has urged that the order be made effective at once. For this reason the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
